Registration Timeline

February 23: Registration opens for non-partner groups.

April 27: Registration closes.

NO refunds available after this date.

Substitutions (gender-based) for cancelled students are allowed.

May 1: Payment invoices are sent out to churches.

All online payment for individuals are due.

May 11: All final group balance payments are due.

NO changes or replacements after this date.

(Refunds for inability to attend the event because of unforeseen circumstances will be dealt with on a case by case basis.)

Registration Costs

\$300/person - the registration fee for an individual

The church will cover \$325 (which is the remaining amount to get the \$625 registration fee).

The church will also cover transportation costs.

The current transportation plan is to drive there and back ourselves. We will leave Friday night, spend Friday night at a hotel in Nebraska, and then drive to Colorado on Saturday. On the return we will leave the YMCA of the Rockies Wednesday morning and return to Cedar Hills Wednesday night.

Additional Costs
